EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS FOR YOUR VEHICLE

Some basic information for both Summer and Winter months

As we know **SUMMER** months can be very warm or down right HOT. Here is a list of basic supplies to keep with you in case of an EMERGENCY or BREAKDOWN (Not in any specific order)

- 1. Jumper cables
- 2. Extra water or antifreeze/coolant for the vehicle
- 3. First Aid Kit
- 4. Spare tire (check regularly)
- 5. Jack/star wrench
- 6. Water to drink/bottles (electrolytes)
- 7. Snacks/activities for kids (books)
- 8. Flashlight (night time emergencies) with extra batteries
- 9. Safety traffic triangles/road flares
- 10. Fully charged phone/charger
- 11. Whistle
- 12. Rope/tow strap
- 13. Cutting device/pocket knife
- 14. Gloves/duct tape
- 15. Basic tool kit/hand cleaner

WINTER MONTHS (Not in any specific order)

Same as above, but here are a few that are different to consider

- 1. Matches/lighter
- 2. Cat litter (to help get you out of the snow)
- 3. Small shovel
- 4. Ice/snow scraper
- 6. Tire chains
- 7. High protein food

BEFORE GOING ON A ROAD TRIP/TRAVELING

- 1. Check wiper blades
- 2. Inspect battery terminal/gauge
- 3. Test lights/flashers/blinkers, etc.
- 4. Check tires/spare
- 5. Keep fuel level at 1/2 tank at the minimum to avoid running low and to stay warm if problems arise such as; stalled traffic, stuck in the snow, or getting lost.

THINGS TO CONSIDER

- *Is my vehicle running in tip top shape? (At all times)
- *Extra medicine/Medication (Tylenol/Ibuprofen, etc./Prescription)
- *Car escape tool (Window breakaway/Seat belt cutter
